<p>ALBERTA</p> <p>Note: The ADA discontinued the practice of publishing a provincial fee guide since 1997. Over the past several years, members of the Canadian Life and Health Insurance Association (CLHIA) worked together to determine an industry benchmark. Effective for 2005, this practice has been discontinued. Each insurer is independently determining their increases. As such, competitive increases will not be aligned to those of Manulife. Manulife's figures are based on our own block of Alberta claims data. A 70th percentile threshold is used in determining the increases.
