Dear Brothers,

As a member of the Long Term Disability plan and retiring without being on LTD you are entitled to apply for reimbursement of 41 weeks of LTD premiums upon retirement. Only plan members who are not collecting LTD benefits may take advantage of this premium reimbursement offer.

In order to apply for reimbursement you must telephone or write CP Pension services and request written confirmation that you are on pension and the actual retirement date. The telephone number for CP Pension services is 1-888-511-7557.

I have included a letter to Ms. Lynn Cross, LTD plan manager, with Canadian Benefits Consulting Group requesting reimbursement of the premiums and along with this letter you must include the confirmation letter from CP Pension services. The Board of Trustees meets on a quarterly basis and at the next LTD meeting reviews the application and if everything is in order approve the application for payment.
